**Policy:**

By NAHU By-laws, OAHU past presidents may serve as a voting delegate to the NAHU National Convention, representing either the State Association or any local association within the state. If attendees to the NAHU Convention from Ohio are less than the allowed amount per NAHU By-Laws, OAHU Past Presidents will be eligible to attend the convention as a voting delegate. Under these circumstances, OAHU will provide some financial support to these attendees.

**Procedure:**

1. OAHU Past Presidents interested in attending the NAHU Convention should contact the OAHU President for permission and board approval.
2. Once delegates from OAHU and the locals are determined, if additional delegates are needed, the requesting past presidents will be notified of the availability as a voting delegate.
3. If approved, these individuals will be responsible for filing an OAHU expense report for reimbursement within the timeframe as outlined in the OAHU Expense Reimbursement Board/Leg Policy 2008 0301.

4. Need to be a member in good standing and you need to attend all functions at convention as any other attendee.
